

Background

The importance of quality seeds in increasing crop yields per unit area is well established. To date seed related technologies has advanced tremendously incorporating priming, pelleting and coating which can enhance the performance of the seeds. This also includes the genetically modified seeds for insect resistance and herbicide tolerance.

In Malaysia, the government is looking towards modernizing the agriculture sector particularly in the area of food production. This nobel intention has to be strongly supported by the presence of good quality seeds which is the primary starting point for successful crop production. The Malaysian seed industry is still growing despite being in existance for quite some time.
